Eligibility

Candidate must have Ph.D. in related field with relevant experience minimum of 2 years in hydrogeochemistry. Candidates who have obtained national fellowships from DST, CSIR, etc. will be preferred.

About the Project

Groundwater is a primary source for fresh water in the world. Water quality is a significant criterion in matching water demand and supply. India is coming into the water stress region, and safe drinking water is a necessity for every human being. Therefore, present investigation will carry out on seasonal variation of groundwater quality and assessment of physicochemical parameters in Amethi district, Uttar Pradesh. In this study water and soil samples will be collected from the maximum area of the Amethi district, to understand the physicochemical parameters and also deal with the spatial and temporal variation of heavy metals in groundwater. Its study will provide information to understand the mobilization mechanism of the heavy metals in the groundwater. With this investigation, we will be able to identify safe drinking water sites for a human being.
