Subject: Minor addendum to the **Clause 6.3.3 of UG Ordinance.**

This is to bring to your kind consideration that the following addendum to the Clause 6.3.3 of UG Ordinance may be considered to facilitate the DIC activities of the Institute and promote involvement of UG students towards R&D activities.

“In case of registration of Design & Innovation Centre (DIC) projects as B. Tech. projects, the corresponding DIC project monitoring committee (DIC-PMC) will serve as the evaluation panel of the B. Tech. project. The DIC-PMC will evaluate the projects and submit grades following the academic calendar to the respective DUGC of the Department under which the student is pursuing his/her UG programme.” For such projects, it is not mandatory to have the supervisor(s) from the department under which the student is enrolled for his/her B. Tech./IDD program.

The students desiring to register their DIC project as the B.Tech. project, shall submit the project details along with the consent of project supervisor(s) to the DUGC of the department under which the student is enrolled for B.Tech./IDD programme by the end of previous semester so that the assignment of the project and supervisor(s) is completed by the Department by the First week of the semester in which the project has to commence.

Subsequently, the students in consultation with their supervisors shall submit synopses/work plans for the entire duration of projects within THREE WEEKS from the beginning of the semester. The DIC project evaluation committee (DIC PEC) will serve as the evaluation panel for the B.Tech. project and will do monitoring and evaluation of projects for the whole duration of projects based on the synopses and work plan.

The projects shall be evaluated twice in a semester (Mid semester and End Semester Examination). Supervisor(s) will award marks out of 30 based on performance. The Evaluation Panel(s) will conduct viva - voce/ seminar on specified dates and evaluate in 70 marks on the performance in the mid semester and the end semester examination and the regular monitoring during the semester. The evaluation panel to submit the grades to the corresponding DUGC under which the student is enrolled for his/her B.Tech./IDD programme for tabulation purposes.
