Introduction

SCHEMCON 2024: Students' Chemical Engineering Congress (SCHEMCON) is an annual event organized by the Institutes having Student Chapter (SC) of the Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers (IIChE) under one of its Regional Centers (RC). It serves as a premier platform for Chemical Engineering students, offering opportunities to explore, learn, and gain insights into the ever-expanding realm of chemical engineering. SCHEMCON-2024 marks the 20th annual session and is jointly organized by IIChE RGIPT Student Chapter, the Department of Chemical and Biochemical Engineering at Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Petroleum Technology, Jais (RGIPT) and the Amethi Regional Center of IIChE.

Organizing Institute

Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Petroleum Technology: The Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Petroleum Technology Jais, Amethi, Uttar Pradesh was established by the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MoPNG), Government of India by an Act of the Parliament in 2007. The institute was accorded with the status of an Institution of National Importance and its NIRF ranking in 2023 is 79th in engineering category. The institute is co-promoted as an energy domain specific institute by six leading oil public sector units (ONGC, IOCL, OIL, GAIL, BPCL, and HPCL) in association with the OI DB. The institute is associated with the leading International Universities/ Institutions specializing in the domain of petroleum, petrochemicals, and energy sectors. There are 7 departments and 2 centers offering 13 UG and 6 PG programs and doctoral programs in STEM. The **Department of Chemical and Biochemical Engineering (CBE)** at RGIPT aims to train and produce experts with strong technical background and social commitment to meet the energy demand of the nation. The Department, offers BTech degree in Chemical Engineering along with specialization in Renewable Energy Engineering, and Polymer and Petrochemical Engineering programs as well as MTech and PhD programs.

How To Reach: RGIPT is located on RaeBareilly-Sultanpur highway (NH128), nearly 25 km east of RaeBareilly and 110 km away from its nearest airport at Lucknow. It can also be reached by train. Nearby railway stations are Jais/ Kasimpur/ Amethi/ RaeBareilly.

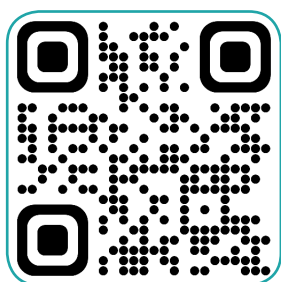
IIChE-Amethi Regional Centre
