NOTIFICATION

It is to notify that the competent authority has decided that the candidates shortlisted for the post of Deputy Registrar have to appear for an objective examination to restrict the no. of candidates to 14, i.e. 7 candidates for each post. **The objective examination will only be a screening process and will not contribute to the merit of the selection process.**

Further, the Objective Exam will be of 100 Marks and consist of 100 MCQ-type questions, wherein 50 MCQ in PART-A will be aptitude testing and 50 MCQ in PART-B will be domain knowledge testing. There will be a negative marking of -0.25 for each wrong answer. The candidates securing 40% marks (i.e. 40 out of 100 Marks) will be eligible to appear for the Phase-1 (Presentation) and Phase-2 (Interview). However, only the top 14 candidates in merit will be declared eligible to appear for the presentation and interview.

The final merit will be prepared on the basis of score as mentioned below:

PART – A (50 Marks)

PART – B (50 Marks)

Provisions of Delegation of Financial Powers Rules (DFPR), NEP 2020.
- Recruitment & Reservation Rules, GPF / NPS Rules & Regulations, Public Financial Management System (PFMS), Income Tax ACT 1961 along with the Finance Act, Budget and Accounting in Autonomous Bodies, General Financial Rules 2017, Academic Administration, Ordinances for all academic / research programs, RGIPT Act & Statutes, Conduct of Board of Governors Meetings, Finance Committee, Senate Meetings, RTI Act 2005, The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 ("POSH Act")


